Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for a review process called Federal Verification. The University of Pennsylvania Student Financial Aid office is required by law to confirm the information you and/or your parent(s) reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided accurate information, your FAFSA will be compared with your 2020 Federal tax and/or W-2 information, this worksheet, and other requested documentation, if needed. If there are differences we may need to make corrections to your FAFSA and/or ask for additional information.

To complete this process, you must provide to the University your unexpired, signed, valid <u>government issued ID</u> (such as driver's license, military ID, passport, etc.), <u>proof of high school completion</u>, and this <u>Identity/Statement of Education Purpose Verification Worksheet</u>.

Examples of documents that validate high school completion are listed here (*Please note that only one of these are required*):

- A copy of the student's high school diploma.
- For students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.
- A copy of the student's final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A State certificate or transcript received by a student after the student passed a State authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination).
- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- For a student who was homeschooled in a State where State law requires the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- For a student who was homeschooled in a State where State law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for
 homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent, a transcript (or equivalent) signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists
 the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a
 homeschool setting.
