The University of Pennsylvania is the recipient of Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) made available through both the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and the American Rescue Plan (ARP). Penn is responsible for disbursing these HEERF funds to students with financial need related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Your funds will not be applied to any outstanding student account balances, will not impact your financial aid eligibility for the year, and will not be considered taxable income.

Students enrolled in direct deposit via Penn.Pay will receive an electronic deposit into their bank account. Students not enrolled in direct deposit via Penn.Pay will receive a check mailed to their Learning From Address on file in Penn InTouch. We strongly encourage all students to enroll in direct deposit to receive these funds quickly.
